AED and telephone functioning satisfactory.

Training: Clive Hadrell from First Response is willing to run training sessions for £327.80 each. I recommend that we have two sessions this spring. He is available in April May and June.

Although there are still funds available there will soon be a need for more funding if the cost of these sessions is born by the AED account. There is a need to hold a reseve in the fund of about £500 to cover the cost of contingencies including the replacement of the battery

**Report to Priston Parish Council for Meeting on 30 Jan 2012**

**Key updates since the December meeting:**

- latest Parish Council minutes and agenda;
- Parish Council Register of Interests;
- announcement of Diamond Jubilee celebrations and request for volunteers;

- broadband speed checker moved to home page to facilitate Parish Council survey;
- calendar items, including 2012 Parish Council meetings, Village Hall AGM, Cricket Club VH Social Sketch screening;
- item re new keep-fit sessions in Village Hall on Monday evenings (Parish Council meetings permitting);
- photos from Christmas & New Year and Wassail, and of deer visiting a Priston garden;

- link to news item re local MP seeking own time zone for Somerset.

Councillors may be interested to note that over the last month:

- 641 visitors (ie computers) made 853 visits to the Priston Web;
- of these, 103 visitors had visited the Priston Web previously ie were **returning** visitors;
- the 103 returning visitors made a total of 283 visits ie an average of 2.75 visits each and spent an average of 2min 35secs on each visit;
- the most popular pages for returning visitors were: the Calendar, the Parish Council page, Family History, Festival, Village Hall, Church and Village Directory.
