## **AED Report to Priston Parish Council on 13th July 2015**

The AED has been checked as required and is operational. However the light above the cabinet is not working. It looks as though it has received a heavy blow, possibly by a football. The light bulb was broken and the light sensor has also been damaged. The light bulb has been replaced and action is being taken to repair the sensor. I appeal to anybody who causes damage to any part of the installation to report it immediately.

Training: A course has been arranged for Wednesday 5th August at 7.00pm, venue yet to be finalised. Priority will be given to those whose certification has expired and people who wish to be trained and require initial familiarisation.

Second Generation AE: Progress is being made for the purchase of an instrument which will be much more user friendly and will guide the operator to more effective cardio-pulmonary resuscitation.
