### **Footpaths and Bridleways Report for PPC Meeting 11th May 2015**

The report for the last meeting stated that, in response to requests from some parishioners, arrangements were being made to replace three stiles:

- a) On Footpath 20/1 at entrance to copse just past Priston sewage farm.
- b) On Footpath 20/1 next to gate from road to sewage farm (b).
- c) On Footpath 20/9 between Upper Hare Mead and Upper Furlong (close to owl barn).

a) and c) were to be replaced by kissing gates and b) by a pedestrian gate.

a) and b) were replaced in April but unfortunately in the case of c) (where the stile causes particular difficulties for some parishioners) the landowner has refused to allow replacement.
