

**An extraordinary meeting of Priston Parish Council was held on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2012 in the Village Hall, Priston commencing at 7.45pm**

The Chair was taken by Councillor Hopwood and Councillors Cross, Davies, Girdlestone and Whybrow and the Parish Clerk were present. The Chairman welcomed village residents Mr Bottle, Mr Cross, Mrs Davies, Mr Hughes, Mr Jones, Mrs Rideout, Mr and Mrs Thacker and District Councillor Veale.

Councillor Hopwood advised residents that, prior to the formal consideration of the application by the Parish Council, they would all be given the opportunity to address the Council and also that residents may write to Planning Services if they so wish.

Several residents took advantage of the opportunity to address the Parish Council and expressed their concerns on various aspects of the application.

1. **Apologies** received from Councillors Pattison and Lippiatt.
2. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and consider the response to Planning Services in respect of **Planning Application 12/01748/FUL Land between Church Lane and Church Farm Lane, Priston. Erection of new detached dwelling and associated external works.**
3. The application was considered in accordance with the Planning Checklist in use by the Parish Council and a document for discussion was distributed to Councillors and residents. Reference was made to the policies of the BANES' Local Plan (adopted 2007) which were relevant to this application. It was noted the Case Officer had requested further information from the applicant. After extensive discussion and participation by all Councillors, it was agreed a final decision on a recommendation not be made until there had been an opportunity to speak further with the Case Officer. Agreed that a further Planning Parish Council Meeting be arranged to formalise a response to Planning Services.
