HELP KEEP THIS HALL COVID-19 SECURE

- 1. You must not enter if you or anyone in your household has COVID-19 symptoms.**
- 2. If you develop COVID-19 symptoms within 10 days of visiting these premises** you must seek a PCR test and inform the organiser of the event you attended.
- 3. Face coverings are expected and recommended in enclosed crowded spaces,** so take account of this if the hall/kitchen is expected to become crowded.
- 4. Exercise caution with social distancing:** Do not gather at the hall doorways. Enter at the front door and exit via the rear door. Standing or sitting next to someone is lower risk than opposite them. Briefly passing another person in a confined space is low risk. Take especial care with people who are more likely to be vulnerable to Covid-19.
- 5. Use the hand sanitiser provided on entering and exiting the premises.** Clean your hands often.
- 6. Avoid touching your face, nose, or eyes.** Clean your hands if you do.
- 7. "Catch it, Bin it, Kill it".** Tissues should be disposed of into one of the waste bins provided. Then wash your hands.
- 8. Check the organisers of your activity have cleaned door handles, tables, other equipment, sinks and surfaces before you arrived.** The Cleaning Book in the kitchen has a record of the cleaning undertaken by date. Do not share equipment with others.
- 9. Take turns to use confined spaces such as corridors, kitchen and toilet areas.** Ensure the kitchen does not become crowded, and that there is a maximum of one person in the men's urinal and two persons in the ladies' lavatory area at any one time.
- 10. Keep the hall well ventilated.** Keep doors open where possible. Close doors and windows on leaving.
