

PRISTON VILLAGE HALL - ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Priston Village Hall takes all practicable steps to minimise the negative impact of the village hall on the environment:

- rubbish is disposed of in appropriate recycling bins;
- low energy light bulbs are used for lighting;
- the Main Hall heating is designed to operate only when required, i.e. when the hall is actually in use.

The following have been incorporated into Village Hall repair and improvement plans

- thermal insulation improvements;
- the kitchen and toilet areas are to be provided with new background heating and ventilation systems
- improved plumbing works will reduce water usage.
- energy-efficient water heating and also hand driers are proposed as part of the hall improvements.

Installation of solar panels is not feasible because of the village hall's Grade 2 Listing status.

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Village Hall Committee.
