

NOTICE OF CLOSURE OF BYWAY TO ALL NON-PEDESTRIAN USERS

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a closure to **all non-pedestrian users** to Public Byways BA20/18 & BA11/22 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BA20/14 at grid reference ST 6957 6154 (Point A on the Notice Plan below) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly then north-easterly direction for approximately 650 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA11/11 at grid reference ST 7006 6143 (Point B on the Notice Plan below).



This path closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public; namely, the danger caused by a deep trench which has been cut down the middle of the byway by running water on the Englishcombe side of the Parish boundary, rendering passage unsafe for all users other than pedestrians. This closure by notice has come into force with immediate effect and will be effective for 21 days.
