4. Further improve air quality
5. Reduce inequalities

It will place people at its core and help deliver clean growth, by supporting local businesses, as well as helping ensure prosperity can spread.

This consultation provides the chance for you to have your say on how the Council, on your behalf, shapes the future transport system in Bath for the next 10 years.

The Council adopted the Liveable Neighbourhood Polices in December. This plan builds on those policies with a holistic Transport Delivery Action Plan that will identify the transport measures that we want to deliver for those living, working and visiting Bath.
